FINAL DECREE OF DIVORCE

This cause came on this day to be heard before the Honorable Kaye Robillo, Judge of Division 5 of the Circuit Court of Tennessee for the Thirtieth Judicial District at Memphis, upon the original Complaint for Absolute Divorce herein filed by the Plaintiff in this cause, Phillip Haden Vance, Answer having been waived in Marital Dissolution Agreement and Parenting Plan, statement of counsel for the plaintiff, upon oral testimony of the Plaintiff, Phillip Haden Vance, and upon a review of the entire record in this cause, from all of which it appears to the Court that irreconcilable differences exist between the parties and the Plaintiff should be granted an absolute decree of divorce from the Defendant.

The Court further finds that the parties should have joint custody of their minor child: Haden Ashlynn Vance, born October 20, 1994; it further appears to the Court that the Marital Dissolution Agreement and Parenting Plan filed in this cause makes adequate sufficient provision for the care, support and maintenance of the parties' minor children and an equitable division of the parties' marital estate.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED, ADJUDGED AND DECREED AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Plaintiff, Phillip Haden Vance, be and is hereby granted a divorce from the Defendant, Marsha Lynn Bostic Vance, and the parties are restored to the status of unmarried person.
2. That the written Marital Dissolution Agreement and Parenting Plan filed in this cause be, and the same is hereby approved and the Court affirmatively finds that said Marital Dissolution Agreement and Parenting Plan makes adequate sufficient

provision for the care, support and maintenance of the parties' minor children and an equitable division of the parties' marital estate.

3. The Marital Dissolution Agreement and Parenting Plan executed by the parties is hereby incorporated herein by reference.

4. That the Defendant, Marsha Lynn Bostic Vance, is hereby divested of any and all interest she may have in and to the real property located at 3083 Bluefield Street, Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee, 38128 and the same is vested in the Plaintiff, Phillip Haden Vance.

5. That the Defendant, Marsha Lynn Bostic Vance, is hereby divested of any and all interest she may have in and to the real property located at 3075 Darby, Memphis, Shelby County, Tennessee, 38128 and the same is vested in the Plaintiff, Phillip Haden Vance.

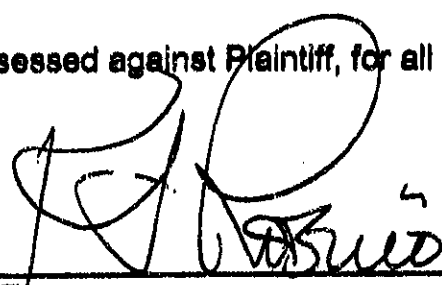

10. The costs of this cause shall be assessed against Plaintiff, for all of which
let execution issue, if necessary.



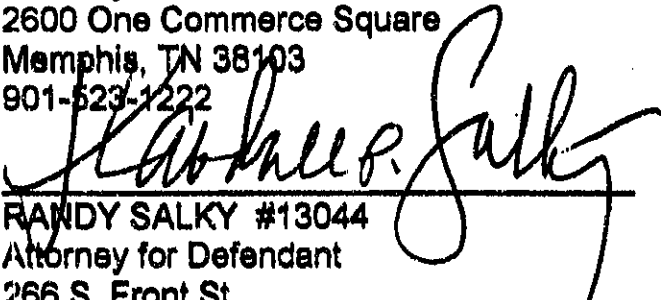

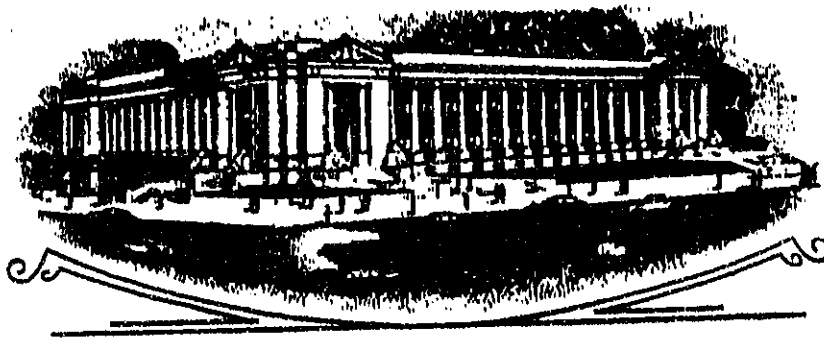
